RING 1 – 9.30AM START. JUDGE TBC

CLASS 1 Young stock - Yearlings.

CLASS 2 Young stock - 2 & 3 year olds.

CLASS 3 In-hand Cob – Any age, Height , colour.

Class 4 - VETERAN IN-HAND (15 YEARS AND OVER, ANY HEIGHT, BREED, TYPE)

CLASS 5 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND veteran COMBINED AGE CLASS - In-hand (15 years and Over)

CLASS 6 In-hand Rescue Horse or Pony any type/breed/age

CLASS 7 In- hand Part/pure Anglo Arab

CLASS 8 In-hand Rare & Foreign Breed

CLASS 9 In-hand Open pony - Any type

CLASS 10 In-hand Open horse- Any type

CLASS 11 IN HAND RIDING PONIES In hand Riding Ponies, stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age, not to exceed 153cms at maturity. Classes may be divided according to entries.

CLASS 12 Young Handlers 11 years and under (may be accompanied by an adult)

CLASS 13 Young Handlers 12 years or over

CLASS 14 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

CLASS15 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND IN HAND Open to In Hand Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A, B, Stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age.

CLASS 16 In-hand Spots, Roans & Dilutes

CLASS 17 IN HAND PIEBALD / SKEWBALD Open in Hand Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding, any age, Open In-hand Qualifier. Any height, age or type. No foals.

CLASS 18 IN HAND RIDING PONIES In hand Riding Ponies, stallion, mare, colt, filly or gelding. Any age, not to exceed 153cms at maturity. Classes may be divided according to entries.

**1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> PLACE IN IN-HAND MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP\*\* IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP TO BE HELD AFTER ALL IN-HAND CLASSES HAVE FINISHED.**

CLASS 19 Tack and Turnout - 10 years & under lead rein welcome

CLASS 20 Tack and Turnout - 11-16 years

CLASS 21 Tack and Turnout - Open

**Tack & Turnout Championship - Only 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 1, 2 & 3 (Winners not eligible for any other Championships) Sash for Overall Winner**

CLASS 22 BEST COMBINATION

CLASS 23 BEST PONY CLUB COMBINATION includes small fence

CLASS 24 WALK AND TROT FIRST RIDDEN

CLASS 25 BEST LEAD REIN any breed

CLASS 26 HORSE/PONY JUDGE WOULD MOST LIKE TO TAKE HOME

CLASS 27 RIDDEN COBS Open Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows

- A) Open Lightweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.
- B) Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.
- B) Open Heavyweight Ridden Cob, mare or gelding, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 155cms.

CLASS 28 MAXI COBS Open Maxi Cobs, mare or gelding 4 years old and over, exceeding 155cms – to be judged as Cobs. Riders any age.

CLASS 29 SHOW PONY LEAD REIN Leading Rein Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle. Lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

CLASS 30 SHOW PONY FIRST RIDDEN First Ridden Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

CLASS 31 RIDDEN SHOW PONIES Open Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. Classes may be divided as follows

- A) Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 13th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

B) Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 128cms but not exceeding 138cms. Riders not to have attained their 15th birthday before 1st January in the current years

C) Show Pony, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 138cms but not exceeding 148cms. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 32 INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Classes may be divided as follows:

A) Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 153cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

B) Open Intermediate Show Riding Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year

CLASS 33 RIDDEN HACKS Open Show Hacks, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

1. A) Small Hacks – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 154cms. Riders any age.
2. B) Large Hacks – mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 154cms but not exceeding 160cms. Riders any age.

CLASS 34 RIDING HORSES Open Riding Horse, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height. Riders any age. Classes may be divided as follows:

A) Small Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

B) Large Riding Horses - mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

CLASS 35 RIDDEN PART BREDS Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Exhibits in this section must be registered in the Part Bred section of their respective Breed Society. Registration numbers must be stated on the entry form. Horses and ponies will not be ridden at the final. Riders any age.

CLASS 36 Best Ridden Rescue Horse or Pony - any type/breed/age.

CLASS 37 VETERAN RIDDEN (15 years and over). Open to horses and ponies of any breed and height.

CLASS 38 Ridden Rare & Foreign Breed

CLASS 39 RIDDEN SPORT HORSE/PONY

CLASS 40 CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE. Open to all Ridden, Lead rein or In hand

CLASS 41 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LEAD REIN Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be led by an attendant and shown in a Snaffle Bridle, the lead rein to be attached to the noseband only.

CLASS 42 MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND FIRST RIDDEN Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies, registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, New Forest, Shetland, and Welsh A or B. Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in any suitable bridle.

CLASS 43 JUNIOR RIDDEN MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND Mares and geldings, 4 years old & over, registered in the respective pure bred Stud Books of Connemara, Dales, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Shetland and Welsh Section A,B,C & D. Riders of Small Breeds not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Riders of Large Breeds not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

CLASS 44 OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh A & B. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.

CLASS 45 OPEN RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND Open to Mountain & Moorland ponies registered with their respective Pure Bred Societies of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest, Welsh C and D. Stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over. Rider any age.

CLASS 46 RIDDEN PIEBALD / SKEWBALD Open ridden Piebald / Skewbald stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over. Riders any age.

CLASS 47 RIDDEN HUNTERS Open Ridden Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 153cms. Riders any age.

Classes may be divided as follows:

A) Lightweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying up to 12.7 stone.

B) Middleweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, capable of carrying 12.7 stone but not 14 stone.

C) Heavyweight Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over capable of carrying over 14 stone.

CLASS 48 OPEN SMALL HUNTERS Open Small Hunter, mare or gelding, 4 years old & over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders any age.

CLASS 49 INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER TYPE Open Intermediate Show Hunter Type, mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January in the current year. CLASS 61 CHAPS (UK) Veteran Qualifier- Ridden, any type, exhibits to exc 15 years.

CLASS 50 Ridden Spot, Roan, and Dilutes.

CLASS 51 Race Horse to Riding Horse – To be registered with Wetherby's.

**1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> PLACED IN RIDDEN CLASSES (APART FROM FANCY DRESS & TACK AND TURNOUT) MAY PARTICIPATE IN THE RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP\* RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP TO START WHEN ALL CLASSES HAVE FINISHED.**

**SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP – To start when all classes finished.**

Class to be split for Ridden and In-hand Championship, each winner will receive a Championship Sash, and 2nd place to receive Reserve Champion Rosette.

Winners & runners up from Championship will be then eligible for the Supreme Champion ( see below)

**Supreme Champion** – will receive Supreme Champion Sash.

2<sup>nd</sup> place to receive Reserve Supreme Champion Rosette.

Age of rider will be based on the rider's age on the 1st January 2017

Some classes may be split if sufficient entries.

Upon entering you agree to adhere to our terms and conditions which can be found on our website .

1 We reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate or split any class or classes.

2 We reserve the right to refuse any entry.

3 On no account is any animal to be exhibited under a judge who is known to have bred, leased, sold or produced that animal.

4 All colts and stallions over 2 years old must be correctly bitted with a snaffle type bridle and led by a handler who has attained their 14th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.

5 The judge's decision is FINAL

6 Anyone conducting themselves in a disorderly manner will be asked to leave the showground.

7 Exhibitors must ensure all animals are sound.

8 It is recommended that all exhibitors have PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE.

9 Correctly secured skull caps/riding hats to the current VG1 or PAS015 2011 must be worn by riders at all times when mounted and by Juniors whilst in the ring.

10 Exhibitors are reminded that all times are approximated.

11 Any animal thought to be suffering from any infectious or contagious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately by the committee.

12 All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times

13 We shall be in no way held responsible for any Loss, damage, injury howsoever caused.

14 Ridden horses must be 4 years and over.

15 STALLIONS – Riders of stallions must have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday in the current year for ponies not exceeding 138cm or 14<sup>th</sup> birthday for stallions over 138cm in any current year
